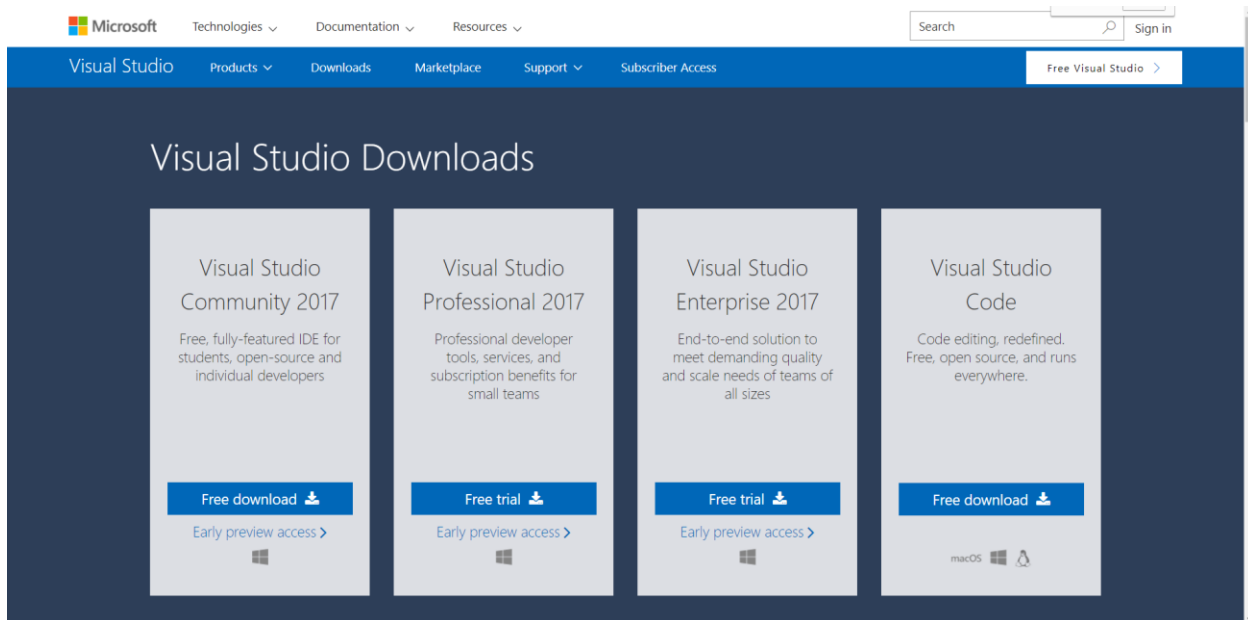


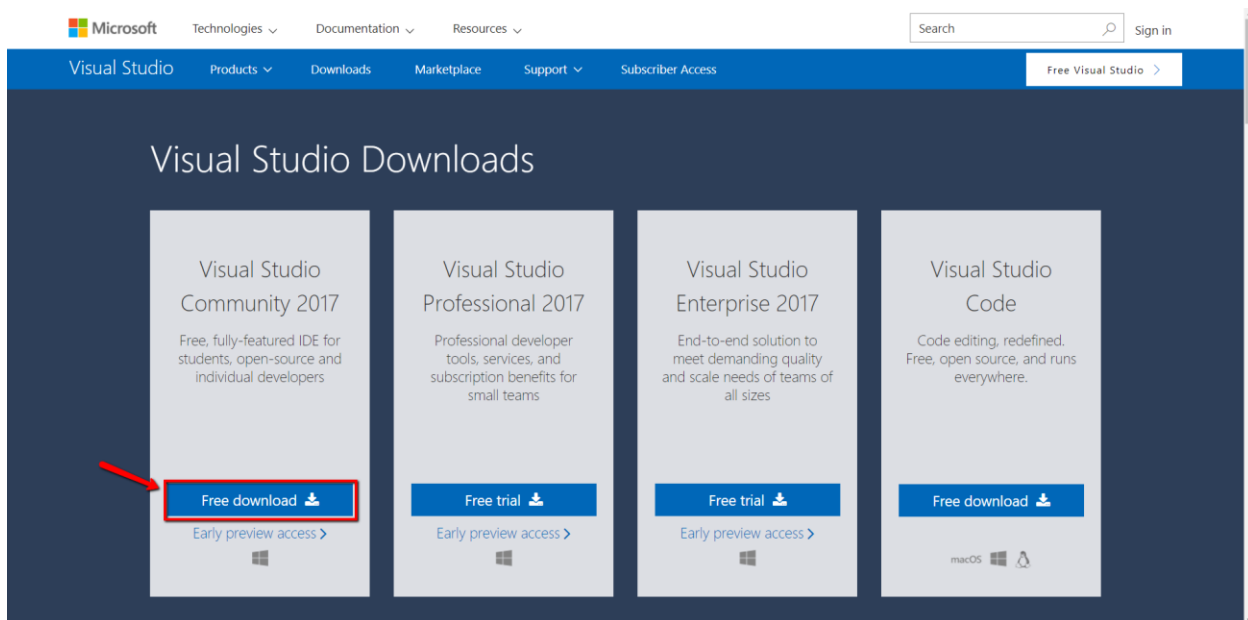
Installing Visual Studio Community 2017


Step 1: Go to <https://www.visualstudio.com/downloads/>



Step 2: Select Free Download under Visual Studio Community 2017




Step 3: Select the Run button



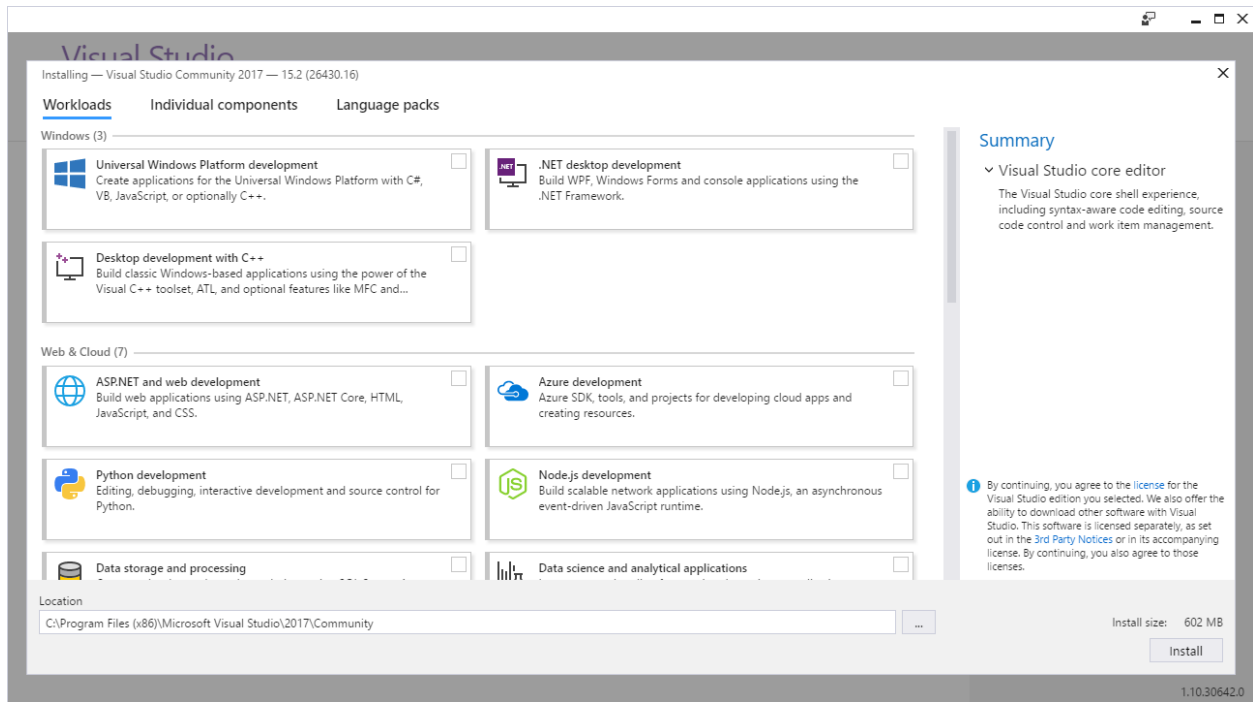

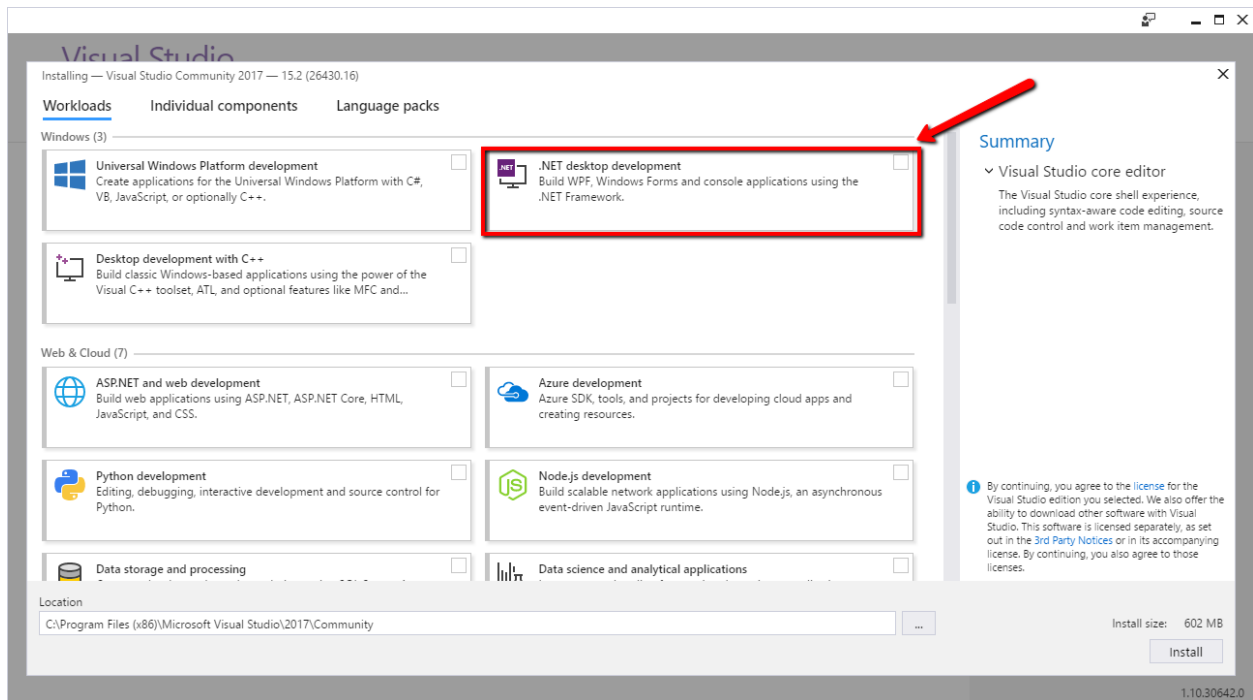

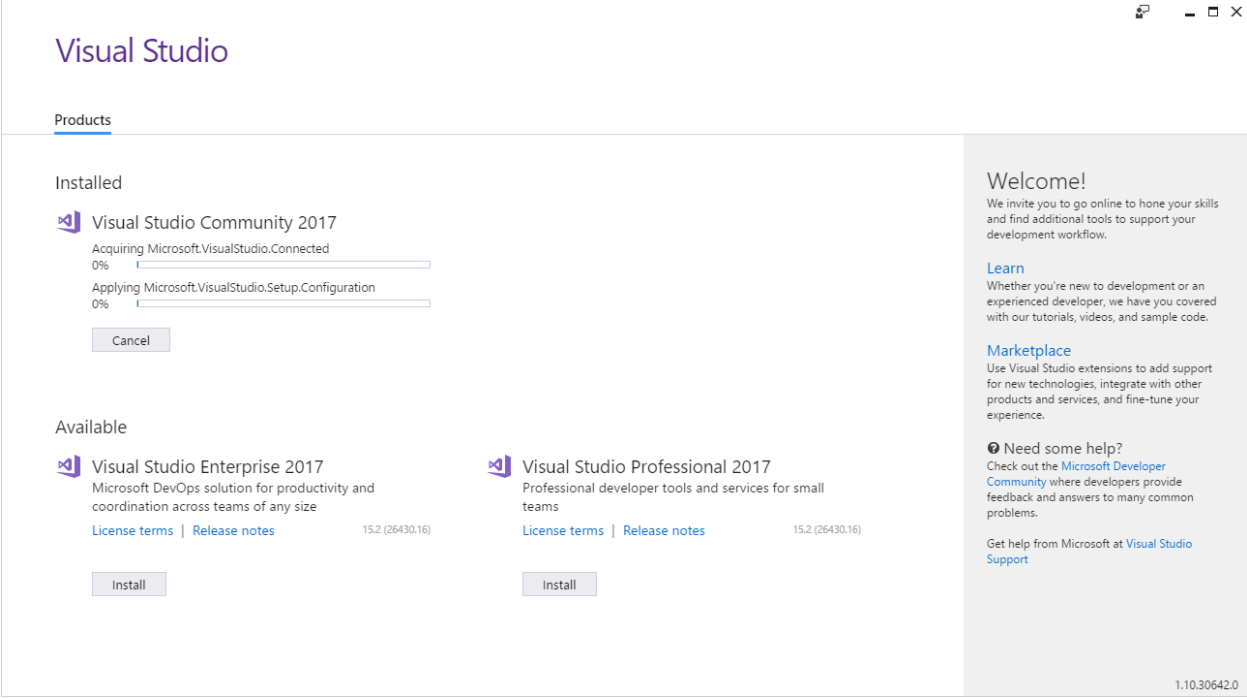
Step 5: Select .NET desktop development
